INTERNSHIP SUPPORT

Are you a small business that could benefit from some extra support from an intern?

The Internship Support programme can work with you to find an intern who matches the needs of your business while providing an opportunity for a student. Our partner The University of Essex has a well-established internship programme where small businesses can connect with a talented pool of students and recent graduates. Funding will enable eligible employers to take on a paid intern for either 6 or 12 weeks.

A graduate internship can also serve as a trial period for a permanent post – although there is no obligation to recruit permanently. We don't dictate exactly what an internship should look like, but we do ask that it is a valuable opportunity, which includes an element of learning and development for the intern.
